

Orono and AFSCME Council 93 File Agreement Town Manager Update -- April 27, 2023

We are pleased to share that the Town of Orono and AFSCME Council 93 have filed an Agreement on Appropriate Bargaining Unit with the Maine Labor Relations Board. The Agreement, a product of collaborative negotiations between the Town and AFSCME, identifies nine administrative job classifications covering twelve professional and clerical staff positions. The Agreement also excludes several categories of employees that AFSCME agrees should not have been included in AFSCME's original petition. Once filed, the Maine Labor Relations Board will determine the next steps in this collective bargaining unit certification process.
