

TOWN OF ORONO ELECTION WORKER INFORMATION FORM

Per Maine State Election Law, election workers cannot be an employee of a political party, a candidate for office or a member of a candidate's immediate family. In addition, a person cannot have a direct pecuniary interest in the results of a referendum question which appears on the ballot. At a minimum, workers must be a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age and establish a voting residence in Maine.
